



Information Fact Sheet

“Camp Harvest” will be held at Children’s Harbor in Alexander City, Alabama on October 26 – 28, 2018. Our weekend will consist of fellowship, food and fun fall activities, along with educational sessions for the whole family!

Consumer Member Registration Fee: \$10.00 per person (\$50.00 Maximum per family for consumers)
Registration fee must be mailed or submitted online with your registration form by the deadline date for us to process your request for attendance.

Registration Fee: \$150.00 per person for guest(s) who do not qualify under the Consumer or Industry Sponsorship Requirements

Below is important information that you will need to know to register for this family event.

- ☀ Due to limited availability and the increased membership and participation, Camp Harvest is reserved for **Consumer Members** (must be registered as a member of HBDA); and **Industry Members**; (includes those sponsoring the event, and covered as a representative, under the sponsorship level).
- ☀ Food and lodging will be provided to your registered attendees subject to availability. There is no charge for the activities except for our special craft class (if offered). There will be a charge to purchase the kit for your project if you sign up, but no charge for the instructional class.

Consumer Member

Any person diagnosed with Hemophilia (A or B), Von Willebrand Disease, or any other bleeding or clotting disorder, including any person who is a diagnosed carrier. Parents or legal guardians of a minor affected consumer member and any other minor family member(s) (people living in the same household) qualify as consumer members. An adult affected consumer member can qualify their minor children and their spouse, significant other **OR ONE** other adult so long as that adult does not qualify as an industry member, and that they reside in the same household with the affected adult member.

Industry Member

Any person employed by or representing a pharmaceutical company, specialty pharmacy or any other for-profit business that earns any revenue from serving the bleeding disorders community. All adult members of an industry members’ family (people living in the same household) are considered industry members except for any family member affected by a bleeding disorder, as well as any minor siblings living in the same household.

- ☀ Lodges will sleep 4 - 5 people only. One cabin will be reserved for each qualified family. Families will be responsible for bringing all personal items, and toiletries. One sheet set will be provided for **each person reserved**. We will provide one bath towel and one washcloth per person, along with a pillow and blanket. Any other items you feel you would need should be brought by you.
- ☀ Your online registration form must be filled out completely for HBDA to consider space for your family. Registration must be received, no later than **September 28th, 2018**. **Once your registration is accepted into our system, you will receive a message containing your confirmation information.**

- ☀ Reservations will be made on a first-come, first-served basis with priority given to families with affected member(s) living in the household. **Reservation deadline is September 28th, or until we reach our lodging capacity. If you try to submit your registration after the deadline or once we have reached our lodging capacity, you will not be able to access the online registration form. Please contact the HBDA office should this occur, to determine availability.**
- ☀ Families are encouraged to bring costumes for the children's trick-or-treat night, but they are not required.
- ☀ Families will be responsible for bringing all medications, including factor and ancillary supplies, and will be responsible for the storage and administration of these medicines. We will have nurses available to assist you with infusions if needed. However, the primary responsibility for medications will be with each family. Lodges will not have cold storage facilities, but ice machines are available for coolers.
- ☀ Hours of registration at Children's Harbor will be **Friday, October 26th from 5pm until 8 pm.**
- ☀ If you plan to attend Camp Harvest, and are unable to arrive during the scheduled registration time, you can call **Amanda Jennings @ (334) 478-7822 for special check in arrangements no later than Friday, October 19, 2018 by noon.**
- ☀ The closest hospital to Children's Harbor is Russell Medical Center in Alex City. It is a 15-20-minute drive. Please be sure to bring all insurance cards and medical information in case of emergency.
- ☀ Please be sure to include your e-mail address on your registration form so that we can provide you with additional information should it become available prior to this event.

We hope you will join us for a weekend full of fun! This is a great opportunity to meet other families who share similar obstacles and get to know your HBDA Staff, Industry Partners, and HBDA Board Members.
